Launch World Geography and Cultures

Description:

This course is designed for students at a lower reading level or students who are At-Risk, or in danger of not graduating high school. Launch World Geography and Cultures is designed to meet the needs of online students who have had difficulties with traditional classroom or other correspondence classes that do not meet a student's needs and need to earn a Social Studies credit.

World Geography and Cultures offers a unique, integrated approach to world Geography. Students explore the diverse physical geography, people, environments, cultures, politics, and economies of 23 regions of the world.

Course Organization: The textbook contains twenty-five chapters. Each chapter is broken down into lessons based on learning outcomes. For each lesson, you are required to read a section of the textbook, complete practice problems from the textbook, and then take an online quiz. At the end of each chapter is a test covering material from that chapter.

Materials Required:

- Computer or tablet with Internet access
- AGS World Geography and Cultures Book

• **Quizzes:** Quizzes are computer scored and you can see your incorrect answers immediately so you can retake if necessary. It is also permissible to use notes, study materials, and books on the quizzes.

• **Tests**: You are <u>not allowed</u> to use notes, study materials, and books on the tests. The tests are meant to reflect how much you have learned while completing the lessons and investigations.
